GENERAL INFORMATION

Drop-off is no earlier than 8:45 a.m. and pick-up is no later than 4:30 p.m.
Parents are invited to observe the afternoon repertory sessions from 3:30-4:25 p.m.

What to bring:

- A water bottle that can be refilled throughout the day.
- A wholesome lunch and at least 2 substantial snacks (fruit and crackers, juice and cookies) .
- Please try to avoid refined sugar in your food choices.

What to wear:

- Dress in T-shirt or tank top and shorts. Bring a sweater or sweatshirt.
- Bring a large, old shirt for use as a painting smock.
- Shoes should be either dance shoes or a light-weight tennis shoe with cotton socks.
- NO black soles, NO cros, NO sandals and NO flip-flops.
- On the final day***, wear dark shorts with no lettering. (Camp T-shirt will be provided.)

CARVER CAMP INFORMATION

The Camp takes place from June 28 – July 9, Monday through Friday.

Camp will not be held on Monday, July 5.

The Carver Center for Arts and Technology is located at 938 York Road, Towson, MD 21204.

From the Baltimore Beltway (I-695), take York Road South for ¼ mile.

Turn right at Fairmount Avenue into the Carver parking lot.

Enter at the South end of the building. Follow the signs to the Carver Theatre.

There are two performances on the final day of the Camp; one at 12:00 p.m. and one at 1:30 p.m.

All students are required to participate in both performances.

All students must be picked up by 2:30 p.m. after the final performance on Friday, July 9.

CHESAPEAKE ARTS CAMP INFORMATION

The Camp takes place from July 19 – 30, Monday through Friday.

The Chesapeake Arts Center is located at 194 Hammonds Lane, Brooklyn Park, MD 21225.

From the Baltimore Beltway (I-695), take exit 3A, Route 2 (Ritchie Highway) North, for ¾ mile.

Turn left at Hammonds Lane, then right into the parking lot just past the shopping center.

Drive around the theatre to the back entrance. Enter through the door at the top of the steps.

There is one performance on the final day of the Camp at 12:30 p.m.

All students must be picked up by 2:00 p.m. after the performance on Friday, July 30.

KEY SCHOOL CAMP INFORMATION

The Camp takes place from August 2 – 13, Monday through Friday.

The Key School is located at 534 Hillsmere Drive, Annapolis, MD 21403.

From Route 50 eastbound, take Exit 22 (Aris T. Allen Blvd./Route 665) for 2.5 miles.

Bear right onto Forest Drive east for 2.5 miles. Turn right onto Hillsmere Drive for 1 mile.

Turn right at Carroll Drive. Park in lot.

Escort your child to the Activities Center next to the outdoor amphitheater.

There is one performance on the final day of the Camp at 12:30 p.m.

All students must be picked up by 2:00 p.m. after the performance on Friday, August 13.
